Our **FELLOWSHIP IN LGBTQ COMMUNITY AND ADVOCACY** is rooted in our belief that LGBTQ communities' work for civil rights, healthcare, education, and human dignity is a critical part of building a more just and democratic society. The Fellowship offers emerging and longtime leaders intensive support and training to lead more efficiently and sustainably, and to build healthy alliances to strengthen the voice and power of LGBTQ communities.

## The Fellowship Program offers:

- **The Art of Leadership Training:** An intensive four-day workshop that supports leaders to create and sustain compelling, ambitious and credible visions for their organizations and deal more effectively with organizational challenges.
- **Ongoing Leadership Support:** Expert coaching, custom consultation on issues relating to leadership and partnership and additional leadership resources.
- **Year-End Fellowship Advanced Training and Dialogue Retreat:** A multi-day workshop that provides advanced training in leadership and collaboration to support enduring partnerships in the community, leading to greater collective power, effectiveness, and more substantive policy change.
